

SUMMER CAMP 2020

Please find below some preventative measures and safety protocols being implemented in an effort to ensure a safe environment for your children at BSC camp this summer.

What is the camp registration process?

We will be offering two options to pre-register your child for camp this summer. 1) Visit the Summer Camp Page on our website and click on the [REGISTER HERE >](#) button. This will take you to our online registration process. 2) Contact us directly at 908-203-1600.

Day of Registration on site at BSC. Please note we strongly encourage pre-registering for camp. Day of Registration campers we will need to provide immunization records, doctor's name, address and insurance information to complete registration.

There will be no cash transactions allowed. Payment must be done by credit card.

What are camp hours?

For the 2020 Summer Camp Season, we will be offering full and half day option for KidVenture Camp. KidVenture Full Day camp will run from 9:00am to 4:00pm. KidVenture Half Day camp offers both a morning and afternoon option. The morning half day camp will run from 9:00am to 12:00pm. The afternoon half day camp option will run from 1:00pm to 4:00pm. Campers enjoying a full day of camp or the morning half day option may be dropped off anytime between 7:45am and 9:00am.

Our Sports Camps will run from 9:00am to 12:00pm. Sports campers may be dropped off anytime between 7:45am and 9:00am. Sports Campers can enjoy a full day option with our KidVenture Camp for an additional cost. They would enjoy Sports Camp from 9:00am to 12:00pm, lunch and then join KidVenture Camp for the balance of the day.

Do you offer before and/or after care?

For the 2020 Summer Camp Season we will be eliminating the charge for AM care in an effort to help ease the morning drop off process. Campers may be dropped off beginning at 7:45am at no additional charge. We do offer an after care camp option, PM Care which runs from 4:00pm to 6:00pm for an additional charge of \$16 per child/per day. A snack and drink will be provided for campers in PM Care.

What is the camp pricing?

KidVenture Camp Pricing

Full Day Weekly Camp = \$325 per child/week

Half Day Weekly Camp = \$200 per child/week

Pre-Registered Daily Full Day Camp = \$75 per child/day

Pre-Registered Daily Half Day Camp = \$50 per child/day

Day of Registration Daily Full Day Camp = \$100 per child/day

Day of Registration Daily Half Day Camp = \$75 per child/day

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Do you offer multi week registration discounts?

Yes, we offer multi week discounts for both our Full and Half Day Weekly Camp options. *(Please note that offers and discounts cannot be combined.)*

Full Day Discounts:

6 weeks: \$90 Per Camper
8 weeks: \$120 Per Camper
10+weeks: \$200 Per Camper

What is a day of camp like?

Campers will enjoy a fun filled day in our climate controlled facility. Campers will be separated into small groups by age with two BSC Team Members assigned to each group. They will remain with their group throughout the day as they move through the building enjoying various games and activities. Campers will be sanitizing hands as they move from one activity to the next and maintaining social distancing guidelines while moving throughout the building. Bathroom trips will be one camper at a time and escorted by a BSC Team Member to ensure social distancing and hand washing. Campers will enjoy lunch during staggered times, in various areas of the complex with distance seating to ensure everyone's safety.

All games and activities will be done with the utmost safety in mind. Campers will be spread out throughout the building and practicing distancing as much as possible. One small group will be permitted in Laser Tag at a time. If a ball is part of an activity, each camper will be provided their own ball which will be disinfected before and after each use. Unfortunately, handshakes and high fives will be discouraged. As a precaution to ensure the safety of our campers, we will not be taking any off-site field trips this summer. Our campers will however enjoy special guests in lieu of our traditional off-site trips throughout the summer.

Given the current uncertain circumstances, use of the Arcade, PlayMaze and Gaga will not be allowed. We hope to be able to open them up for camp soon after we open, but not until the state guidelines allow us to and we feel it is the appropriate action to take for everyone's safety.

We will be offering enhanced health screenings for our staff and ensure that all employees wear face masks. Face coverings will be encouraged to be worn by campers and are most essential in times when physical distancing is difficult to maintain. It is understood that face coverings may be challenging to campers (especially younger campers) to wear in all-day settings such as camp.

How will sports camps run?

Activities for our Sports Camps will lean towards a more technical focus. Each camper will have their own ball and equipment to use for the entire day. Campers are welcome to bring their own equipment. Please be sure to have it labeled with name. There will be no sharing. Activities will include relay races, individual skill development, ball work and speed/agility exercises. Our soccer and basketball camps will also incorporate specific drills for shooting technique.

What are the lunch options?

You are welcome to pack a lunch for your child to bring to camp. We do also offer a hot lunch option which can be purchased for an additional \$6 per camper/day. The purchased lunch option includes a drink, lunch item and snack. Our camp menu is featured on our website and can be printed out and brought in with your camper each day. Lunch can be pre-paid at the time of registration or you are welcome to keep a credit card on file for daily processing. Unfortunately, we will not be able to offer lunch bunch for our morning campers this summer. All morning and sports campers will need to be picked up by 12:00pm. Full day campers will be provided a hot lunch on Friday's at no additional cost.

Can my child purchase a drink and/or snack?

Yes, we offer a variety of drink options as well as a wonderful selection of snacks that are peanut/tree nut free. Money can be added to a BSC Fun Card for your camper at the time of registration to be used during the camp day for a drink and/or snack. A Fun Card is an in-house card that campers use for snacks. Parents/Caregivers can add money to these cards for campers to use throughout the day for a drink or snack. For the safety of our campers all drinking fountains have been temporarily turned off. Campers are welcome to bring bottled water or their own reusable water bottle. We will have water pitchers throughout the building with single use, disposable cups to ensure campers stay hydrated throughout the day.

What is the drop off process?

In order to maintain social distancing this year, dropping off and picking up will all be done outdoors. Parents/Caregivers, you will not need to leave your vehicles.

You will be greeted by a BSC Team Member outside when you arrive at the main entrance. If your camper is pre-registered, your child will have their temperature taken while still in the car. If a camper has a temperature 100.4 or over, you will not be able to drop them off. If all is well, your Camper will be escorted into the building by a BSC Team Member, hand sanitizer will be dispensed and they will be brought to their assigned group and given a wristband.

If your child is not pre-registered, you will be guided to the back of the building to meet with a BSC Team Member, who will assist you with registering your camper. Your camper will remain in the car with you until their temperature is taken and properly registered. They will then be escorted into the building by a BSC Team Member.



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What is the pick-up process?

If your child is with us for morning half day KidVenture or a sports camp the pick-up time is 12:00pm. If your child is with us for afternoon half day KidVenture or full day KidVenture the pick-up time is 4:00pm. If your child is with us for PM Care the pick-up time is 6:00pm. Unfortunately, we will not be able to offer lunch bunch for our morning campers this summer. All morning and sports campers will need to be picked up by 12:00pm.

Morning/Sports Campers - One of our team members will be ready to greet you at the main entrance beginning at 11:45am. You must remain in your vehicle. Please be sure to have a photo id ready to ensure a safe pick up of your camper. You will receive a pick up pass once your ID has been matched to a camper and directed to the designated location to pick up your camper. A team member will bring your camper to your vehicle with all of their belongings. Please remain in your vehicle during the pick-up process. We will ensure the safe delivery of your camper to you.

If you will be arriving for pick-up prior to 11:45am please let us know at drop off or contact us at 908-203-1600 so we can ensure your camper is ready for you when you arrive. We will not be permitting any outside guests in the complex during our camp day. Please know this is in an effort to limit contact and maintain the safety of our campers while they are with us.

Afternoon/Full Day Campers - One of our team members will be ready to greet you at the main entrance beginning at 3:45pm. You must remain in your vehicle. Please be sure to have a photo ID ready to ensure a safe pick up of your camper. You will receive a pick up pass once your ID has been matched to a camper and directed to the designated location to pick up your camper. A team member will bring your camper to your vehicle with all of their belongings. Please remain in your vehicle during the pick-up process. We will ensure the safe delivery of your camper to you.

If you will be arriving for pick-up prior to 3:45pm please let us know at drop off or contact us at 908-203-1600 so we can ensure your camper is ready for you when you arrive. We will not be permitting any outside guests in the complex during our camp day. Please know this is in an effort to limit contact and maintain the safety of our campers while they are with us.

PM Care Campers – One of our team members will be ready to greet you at the main entrance beginning at 5:30pm. You must remain in your vehicle. Please be sure to have a photo ID ready to ensure a safe pick up of your camper. You will receive a pick up pass once your ID has been matched to a camper and directed to the designated location to pick up your camper. A team member will bring your camper to your vehicle with all of their belongings. Please remain in your vehicle during the pick-up process. We will ensure the safe delivery of your camper to you.

If you will be arriving for pick-up prior to 5:30pm please let us know at drop off or contact us at 908-203-1600 so we can ensure your camper is ready for you when you arrive. We will not be permitting any outside guests in the complex during our camp day. Please know this is in an effort to limit contact and maintain the safety of our campers while they are with us.



What if your child has special instructions/medication?

Our team is available to discuss any special instructions, allergies and or medications that your camper may have while they are with us at the BSC. Please let us know during the registration process as well as on the registration form of any special instructions and if your child has medication such as epi-pens or inhalers that they need with them during the day. Please hand them to the team member receiving your child in the morning at drop-off. We will be sure to send it back home with your camper at the end of each day unless otherwise instructed.

Are your team members CPR certified? Do you have an AED on site?

Yes, all of our camp team members are CPR certified and have received Anaphylaxis and Epinephrine Auto-Injector training. Additionally, our management team are all trained and certified in First Aid and how to use our AED (Automated External Defibrillator).
